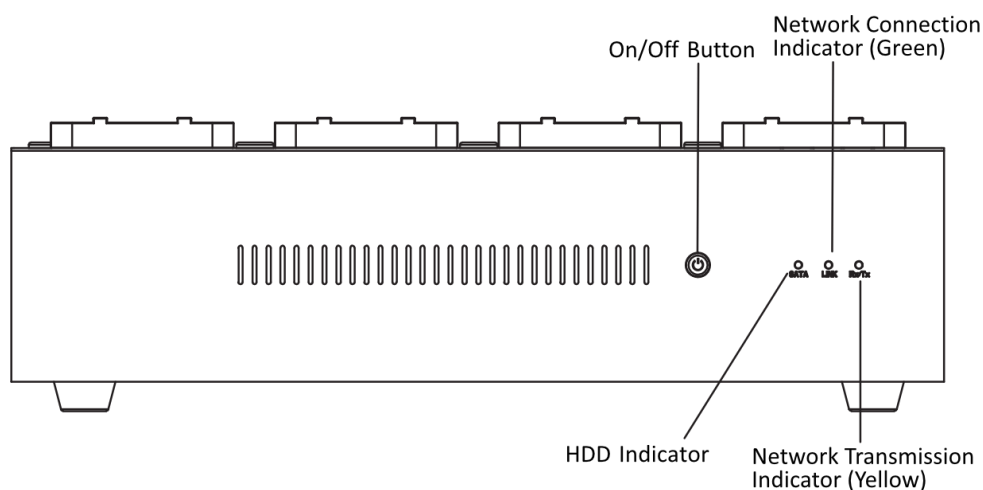


Figure 1-1 Front View

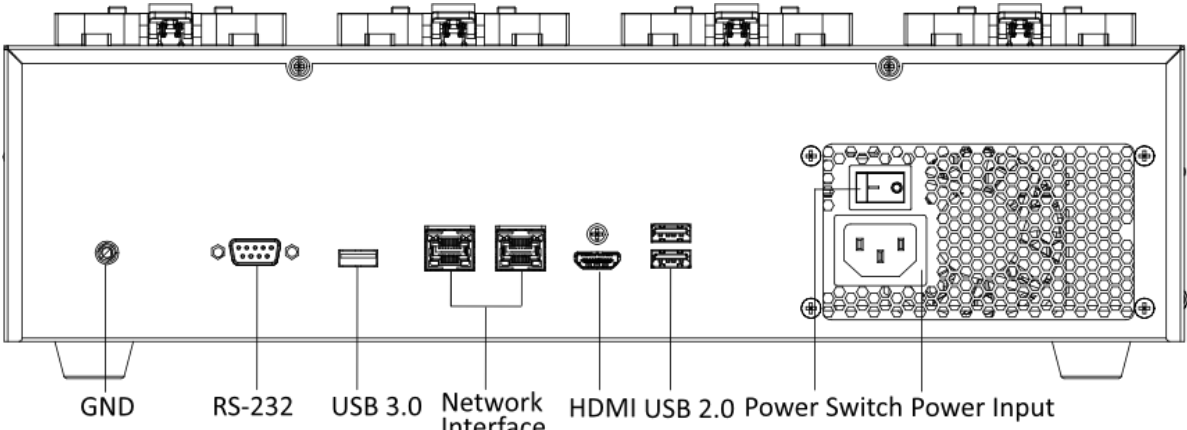


Figure 1-2 Rear View 1

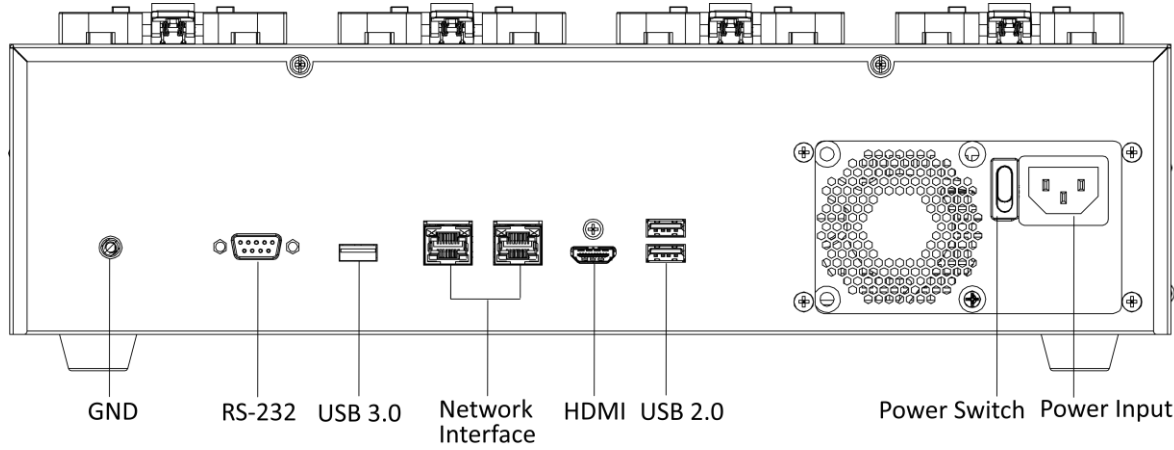


Figure 1-3 Rear View 2

Top View

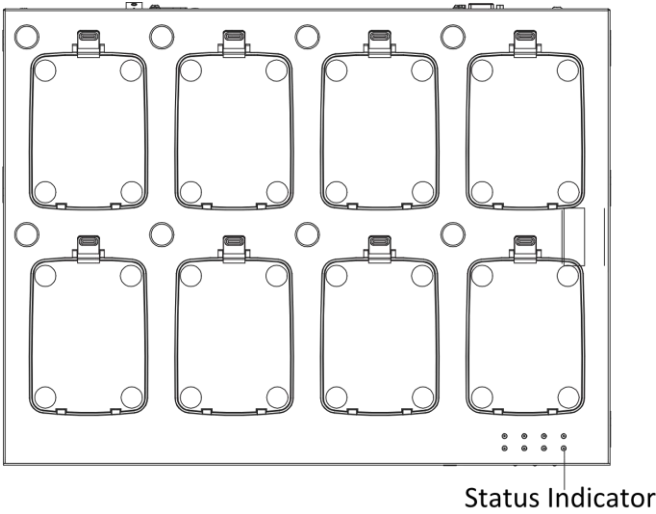


Figure 1-4 Top View

Table 1-1 Interface Description

Name	Description
On/Off Button	Turn on or off the station.
HDD Indicator	Green light indicates the HDD is working normally; Light off indicates HDD failure.
Network Connection Indicator	Solid green indicates that network is connected.
Network Transmission Indicator	Flashing yellow indicates data transmission.
GND	Connects to the grounding cable.
RS-232	Serial port for debugging.
USB 2.0/3.0	Connects to a mouse or USB flash drive. Charging or connecting to other loads is prohibited.
Network Interface	Connects to the network cable.
HDMI Interface	Connects to the external display.
Power Switch	Turn on or off the power supply.
Power Input	Connects to the power cord for power supply.
Status Indicator (Data Collection and Charging)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Flashing: The body camera is connected and data collection is in progress. ● Solid: The body camera is connected and data is transmitted. ● Off: The body camera is not connected.
